Last month I wrote about how I had made the decision to appoint a director in Sri Lanka as I am not going to be able to travel there and spend long periods of time.

Actually the ministry has continued for four and one half years now without my being there, maybe I'm not as indispensible as I thought. With phone calls, emails and text messages things have continued to go well.

I had asked my nephew by marriage, Niranjan if he and his wife Sona would consider taking on the director position there. After praying about it for two weeks he called and said, "we have complete peace that this is indeed

what God wants us to do"! Wow, I started crying tears of joy and couldn't even speak for awhile.

Their decision to do this has made other decisions I needed to make much easier. I am very confident that God will use them in a wonderful way to continue the work there in my absence.

Just this morning I was speaking with him and he wants to do some online Bible courses so that he would be even better prepared to preach and teach.

His wife is Shanthi's niece, her name is Sona and they have two children Nataniya age 5 and Shawn 4 months now I think.



They will begin working full time July first and they are very excited about this change in their lives. Please pray for them!

Now for more change. This could be very long I'll try to keep it short.

I have decided that the best use of my time here in the States is to have a located ministry here. Shanthi and I had discussed this numerous times but could never pursue this due to her illness.

The preacher in the church I have attended here in Joplin, Villa Heights Christian Church, for the past 37 years was retiring. I finally, after MUCH prayer, decided I would put in my application for the position but I really didn't know what to expect for sure.

This was not an easy decision for me to make as Sri Lanka has been my life and ministry for twenty years. I had discussed it with the Lamp Lighters board of directors and my family. One thing that kept coming up was how in life chapters close and new ones open, in other words change.

After about a two month wait I was selected, interviewed, approved by the elders and voted in by the congregation to take on the ministry, my official start date is June first.

So you may be asking, so what about Lamp Lighters ministry? It WILL continue and I WILL continue to be involved but mostly from here.

The monthly newsletter will continue bookkeeping and all things necessary for the ministry I will continue to do here. I hope and plan to go back to Sri Lanka occasionally but probably only every year or two for a short visit.

I will no longer draw a salary from Lamp Lighters as I will be working full time for Villa Heights.

I want to take the opportunity to ask you to continue your support for the ministry as still the preacher's salaries must be paid, properties are yet to be purchased, and buildings yet to built, along with Christmas, VBS, and other programs that will need funding.

Big changes for me and the ministry but God will be glorified through this. These changes are necessary to ensure the future of the ministry. I am putting on a different hat but the ministry there will continue and will need support.
