CHURCHES ABLE TO REOPEN

We praise God we've been able to reopen the doors to worship Lord Jesus in the churches. We have been shut down for more than 2 months period and all gatherings of any kind were stopped.

We got the written permission to have worship services with limited people on June 10th. We held worship services on the next day and believers eagerly participated and praise God.

Very strict guidelines have been issued to follow while having services. But we are very glad that they gave permission to have services!

PROBABLY NO VBS AGAIN THIS YEAR

As you know the situation in Sri Lanka didn't come back to complete normal, especially the schools have not reopened yet.

The government has not given any information about starting the schools until August. School will start after the vaccination of all teachers and students is completed. These have begun for teachers but the students must be vaccinated also before returning to school. All the examinations have been postponed to November and December which some normally take place in August.

Also we have not received permission to start Sunday school or any gatherings of children in any service.

So due to school starting, exam dates changed and Covid restriction there will not be enough time to conduct VBS again this year.

Please pray for the situation to come to normal so we can have Christmas programs this year.
