Along with this there are fewer school days so there are many private classes for the students to catch up on the syllabus.

Therefore Sunday school attendance is very poor. However we continue to try and have some kind of activities to bring the kids to the church.

As you have just read there are many far reaching effects from Covid beyond the illness itself.

While our situation seems to be coming back to a more normal state here in America, that is simply not the case in Sri Lanka and many other countries as well.

Sri Lanka's newly established government has their hands full to try and turn things around. It will probably be years before they can get back to a more stable situation.

Satan is definitely using this to his advantage making it difficult for the churches to worship, function, and reach out with the Gospel of Jesus. We know that Satan may win the battle, but because of Jesus we win the war!
